ABSENCE NOTIFICATIONS

Fresno USD will notify the parent or guardian of the student who missed <u>3 or more unexcused days or 7</u> or more excused days within the current school year through a letter mailed to the address on file.

Each letter specifies what caused the letter to be sent.

- 1st Notification of Truancy upon 3 Unexcused absences*
- 2nd Notification of Truancy upon 6 Unexcused absences*
 - Conferences Notification after 6 Unexcused absences and requires a meeting with a school administrator
- 3rd Notification of Truancy upon 9 Unexcused absences and after an attempt to meet with the school administrator
- 1st Excessive Excused Absence Letter upon 7 Excused absences**
- 2nd Excessive Excused Absent Letter upon 14 Excused absences**

Note: *Unexcused absences are classified as UNVERIFED, UNEXCUSED, and/or TARDIES OVER 30 MINUTES

**Excused absences are classified as ILLNESS, EXCUSED, and/or DOC NOTE...Excused absences do not change the classification of the student to a TRUANT

<u>To prevent a Notification of Truancy</u>, the parent_must contact the school's attendance office within 3 days of the absence to excuse the absence; however, if the absence is deemed unexcused, the student will still be in violation of the district's attendance policy. Failure to update the absence(s) may result in an unwarranted truancy letter.

<u>The Excessive Excused Letter is informational</u> and is used to notify the parent if the student is absent from school for an excessive number of days due to reasons considered excused; however, the student is in danger of missing substantial learning time.
